



Delhi University Common University Entrance Test (CUET) 2023

The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) is being introduced for admission into all UG Programmes in all Central Universities for Academic session 2023-24 under the Ministry of Education, (MoE). The Common University Entrance Test (CUET) will provide a common platform and equal opportunities to candidates across the country, especially those from rural and other remote areas and help establish better connect with the Universities. A single Examination will enable the Candidates to cover a wide outreach and be part of the admissions process to various Central Universities.

Eligibility –

- No age limit however, the candidates may require to fulfill the age criteria of the Institute(s) to which they are desirous of taking admission.

- The candidates who have passed the class 12 /equivalent examination or are appearing in 2023 are eligible

Steps for Application –

- Read carefully before applying <http://bitly.ws/AZU3> (information Bulletin)
- Register at <https://cuetsamarth.ac.in/>
- Upload required documents and to submit to get an OTP.
- Submit OTP and log in to the portal to complete application form.
- Once, all the details are filled, verify it and submit your fee.

Note: Students must check all of the checklist (personal details + Test paper selection + declaration) before the final fee submission. Also, students must read the information bulletin of the respective University before test paper/subject selection.

Documents –

- Recent photograph should be with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against a white background.
- Scanned photograph and signature should be in JPG/JPEG format.
- Scanned photograph should be between 10 kb to 200 kb.
- Scanned signature should be between 4 kb to 30 kb.
- Scanned copy of the Category certificate (SC/ST/OBC/EWS etc.) should be between 50kb to 300kb in pdf (If eligible).
- Scanned copy of the PwBD certificate should be between 50 kb to 300 kb in pdf (If eligible).

Note: All the documents should be clear and clearly legible. Otherwise, it may cause rejection.
