



Joint Entrance Examination (JEE) Mains 2023

The Joint Entrance Examination, JEE (Main) comprises two papers. **Paper 1** is conducted for admission to Undergraduate Engineering Programs (**B.E/B.Tech.**) at NITs, IITs, other Centrally Funded Technical Institutions (CFTIs), and Institutions/Universities funded/recognized by participating State Governments. JEE (Main) is also an eligibility test for JEE (Advanced), which is conducted for admission to IITs. **Paper 2** is conducted for admission to **B. Arch and B. Planning** courses in the country. The JEE (Main) – 2023 will be conducted in 02 (two) sessions for admissions in the next academic session

Eligibility –

- No age limit however, the candidates may require to fulfill the age criteria of the Institute(s) to which they are desirous of taking admission.

- Candidates who have passed/appearing the Class 12/equivalent examination in 2021, 2022, or appearing for the same in 2023, are eligible to appear in JEE (Main) – 2023.

Note: JEE Mains is done in two session, first session was done in Jan month and second session is in April. A candidate need not appear in both Sessions. However, if a candidate appears in more than one Session then his/her best of the JEE (Main) – 2023 NTA Scores will be considered for preparation of the Merit List/ Ranking.

Steps for Application –

- Read <http://bitly.ws/AMhr>
- Candidates can apply for JEE (Main) - 2023 Session 2 through the “Online” mode only. The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- Visit <https://jeemain.nta.nic.in/>
- Register for the Online Application Form and note down the system-generated Application Number.
- Log in to the portal to upload required documents and to submit Fee.

Note: Candidate must write his /her Full Name the same as printed on the certificate/marksheet of Class 10 / equivalent Examination otherwise the form will be rejected.

Documents –

- Scanned Photograph of the Candidate in JPG/JPEG format (Size between 10 kb to 200 kb)
- Scanned Signature of the Candidate (Size between 4 kb to 30 kb)
- Scanned Copy of Address Proof (Present and Permanent) (Size between 50kb to 300kb)
- Category certificate in PDF (Size between 50kb to 300kb)
- PwD certificate in PDF (Size between 50kb to 300kb)

Note: The recent photograph should be either in colour or black & white with 80% face (without mask) visible including ears against a white background.
