

## Kendriya Vidyalaya School

The **Kendriya Vidyalayas** (central schools) are a system of central government schools in India that were instituted under the aegis of the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD). It comprises over 1,094 schools in India and three abroad. It is one of world's largest chain of schools. It was started in 1962. All the schools are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Its objective is to educate children of the Indian Defence Services personnel who are often posted to remote locations. With the army starting its own Army Public Schools, the service was extended (but not restricted) to all central government employees.

A uniform curriculum is followed by these schools all over India. By providing a common syllabus and system of education, the Kendriya Vidyalayas are intended to ensure that the children of government employees do not face education disadvantages when their parents are transferred from one location to another.

### Eligibility –

- Students must be passed in Class 10<sup>th</sup> qualifying examination from a recognized school affiliated to CBSE or any state board of education.
- They must be between 14 to 18 years of age as on July 01 of the year of admission including all reserved category students
- Students will be eligible for admissions to Class 11<sup>th</sup> based on their marks obtained in Class 10<sup>th</sup> board examinations. A merit list will be prepared for determining same.
- The students must be studied in English or Hindi medium
- **Science stream** – Students must have obtained at least 60% marks in aggregate of all subjects in the qualifying examination.
- **Commerce stream** - Students must have obtained at least 55% marks in aggregate of all subjects in the qualifying examination.
- **Humanities stream** - Students who were studying in Class 10 of Kendriya Vidyalayas only and should be passed the qualifying examination.

### Steps for Application –

- Visit the official website: [www.kvsangathan.nic.in](http://www.kvsangathan.nic.in)
- Register for new admission by clicking on the link for students registration
- Get the online application form by selecting the state and district and click on 'Proceed'
- Fill the application form carefully by entering personal details, qualifying examination details.
- Click preview to upload scanned copies of themselves and their parent.
- Enter the 'Captcha' security code and proceed to submit the application form
- Log in with the registered username and password and download the filled in application form and get it printed out for future references.
