Steps to Apply

- Visit the official website: www.nmi.gov.in
- Download the form and read the eligibility criteria.
- Fill the application form and affix a passport size photograph along with a photocopy of age proof.
- Send it to the **Assistant Registrar (Academic), National Museum Institute, 1st floor, National Museum, Janpath, New Delhi – 110011.**
- Check the Institute's website for information regarding shortlisted candidates and other important announcements.
- Shortlisted candidates will have to submit a fee of Rs. 5000/- through Demand Draft in the name of - "**NMIHACM New Delhi**"

Documents Required

- All candidates belonging to the SC, ST, OBC categories must enclose self-attested photocopies of caste certificate/ special category certificate in proper format and which should be signed by appropriate authority.
- Application form should be duly supported by self-attested copies of age proof and educational qualifications.

Note – The applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of 'first come, first served'.
