- After registration, log in using the email address and password created during the registration process.
- The candidates shortlisted for the next phase of the selection process will be required to upload the requested documents.

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Document -

- Attested copies of the mark sheets of all years of the undergraduate study and postgraduate study, if any
- Attested copies of scorecards of any qualifying examination taken (Eg. GRE, GMAT, CAT, GATE, etc.)
- Acceptance letter with the fee structure
- Reference letters
- Any document indicating an award of any other funding, scholarship, fee waiver, etc.
- Latest Income Tax Returns of parents
- Attested copy of the passport
