

Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child 2021-22

Post-Graduate Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child 2021-22 is an initiative for girl students of up to 30 years of age who happen to be the only girl child in their families. The scholarship aims to promote girl education and compensate for the direct costs of girl education to all levels.

Eligibility –

- Be a girl student of up to 30 years of age
- Be the only child of the family
- Have taken admission in regular, full-time 1st-year Master's degree program in any designated university or a postgraduate college

Note: Girl students having no brother or girls who are twin daughters/fraternal daughter are also eligible.

Steps for Application –

- Apply: <https://scholarships.gov.in/fresh/newstdRegfrmInstruction>
- Select the state of domicile, scholarship category (Post Matric), scheme type (scholarship scheme), gender, write the applicant's name, date of birth, mobile number, email ID.
- Provide the bank details (Bank name, IFSC Code, Account Number)
- Select Aadhaar or Bank Account Number as identification detail and click on the 'Register' button.
- The mobile number will be verified and an OTP will be generated then you can fill the form.
- An application ID and password will be generated. Use that for future references.

Benefit: A total of 3,000 scholarships will be awarded to girl students from across the country. An amount of INR 36,200 per annum will be provided for a duration of 2 years or the full duration of the postgraduate course.

Documents –

- Scanned copy of Aadhar Enrollment/Aadhar Card
- Student photograph
- Self-attested copy of previous academic mark sheets
- Fee receipt of current course year
- Affidavit regarding single girl child status as prescribed
