The fellowship is a two-year, non-residential programme for young graduates committed to improving the quality of education in India.

Eligibility –

- Final year students/graduates between 20 and 30 years of age
- Past volunteering or work experience in any field
- Passionate about transforming the education system
- Willing to commit to a two-year full-time fellowship

Steps for Application –

- Identifying problems faced by the school/community and designing solutions
