

## AFCAT 2 2026 Notification

Air Force Common Admission Test is also known as AFCAT, a national-level entrance examination conducted by the Indian Air Force twice a year to select both male and female candidates for multiple posts in Flying and Ground Duty [Technical and Non-Technical]. The candidates who pass the Air Force Common Admission Test-2026 (AFCAT Exam) will be shortlisted for the courses that start in July 2027, and they will be granted Short Service Commission (SSC) in the Flying Branch and Ground Duty (Non-Technical and Technical) branches.

### Papers and Eligibility

Category	Education Qualification
Flying Branch through AFCAT and NCC Special Entry	Passed 10+2 PCM minimum of 50% marks
Ground Duty (Technical/Non-Technical) Branches	Minimum 60% marks 10+2 level and a degree in graduation/post-graduation in the field of engineering and technology

Course Commences From	July 2027
Exam Date	08 <sup>th</sup> August 2026

### Steps for Application –

- Visit: <https://afcat.edcil.co.in/>
- Fill up other details such as educational qualifications etc. depending upon the educational qualification of the candidate
- Pay the examination fee as applicable, online using a Credit/Debit Card or Internet Banking
- Candidates are required to upload their scanned color photograph and Signature (in English or in Hindi) in JPEG format
- Login with your Registration Number and Password in the link for “UPLOAD” and thereafter, upload the file/scanned filled
- Upload all the required certificates
- Apply. Print out the acknowledgment for records
- **Fee:** Rs. 550/- + GST (non-refundable)
- **Vacancies:** 379 (For more details with the official website)

### Documents –

- Passport-size photograph: Recent, colored, with light-coloured clothes and a white background
- Scanned Signature: Candidate's signature in a digital format.
- Thumb Impression: Left-hand thumb impression in a digital format.
- Educational Certificates: Mark sheets and passing certificates for Class 10, Class 12, and Graduation/Post-Graduation.
- Valid ID Proof: Aadhaar Card, PAN Card, Passport, Voter ID, or Driving License
