

AICTE Pragati Scholarship for Girls

AICTE Pragati Scholarship 2022 is being offered by the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) under the Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD). Pragati Scholarship Scheme is exclusively available for the girl's candidates enrolled in the first year of technical degree/ diploma courses of AICTE approved institutions. The aim of the Pragati Scholarship Scheme is to provide an opportunity for young girls to further their higher education and thus pursue a successful career. Pragati Scholarship Scheme especially focuses on “Empowering Women through Technical Education”.

Eligibility –

- Pragati Scholarship Scheme is open for girl candidates only. A maximum of 2 girls per family can apply for this scheme.
- Applicants must have taken admission in 1st year of the technical diploma/ degree program of an AICTE approved college.
- The family annual income of the applicant must not exceed 8 lakhs per annum.

Steps for Application –

- There is an only online mode to apply for the Pragati Scholarship scheme.

- Login to your account using your email ID and password
- Fill in all the details, upload all the necessary documents in PNG, JPEG, or PDF format and Submit.

- Caste certificate issued by the competent authority
- Aadhar card required for AICTE Pragati scholarship 2022
- Income certificate
- Scanned photograph and signature
- 10th/ 12th mark sheet (as applicable)
- Fee receipt
- Admission letter to diploma/ degree course
- Bank details for the scheme Pragati Scholarship
- Duly signed declaration by parents confirming the data provided in the Pragati scheme application form is correct
- Certificate issued by the Principal/ Head of the institution
