Eligibility –

- Passed Class 12 (10+2) or equivalent.
- Minimum 45% marks (General/OBC/EWS/PwD).
- Minimum 40% marks (SC/ST).
- Students appearing for Class 12 exams in 2026 can also apply.
- No upper age limit.
