

CBSE: Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) – 2019

The Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India has entrusted the responsibility of conducting the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) to the Central Board of Secondary Education Delhi. The Central Board of Secondary Education will conduct the 12th edition of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) on **07-July-2019 (Sunday)**. The test will be conducted in twenty languages in 97 cities all over the country.

Eligibility –

Primary Stage: Classes I - V	Elementary Stage: VI - VIII
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and passed OR Appearing in final year of 2- year Diploma in Elementary Education	Graduation and passed or appearing in final year of 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education.
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 45% marks and passed or appearing in final year of 2- year Diploma in Elementary Education (by whatever name known), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure), Regulations, 2002.	Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in final year of 4- year B.A./B.Sc.Ed or B.A.Ed/B.Sc.Ed. Graduation with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in 1-year B.Ed. (Special Education)
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in final year of 4- year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed).	Graduation with at least 45% marks and passed or appearing in 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure)
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in final year of 2- year Diploma in Education (Special Education)	Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in final year of 4- year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed).
Graduation with at least 50% marks and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.)	Graduation with at least 50% marks and passed or appearing in 1-year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed.).
Any candidate having qualified B.Ed. Programme recognized by the NCTE is eligible to appear in TET/CTET. Moreover, as per the existing TET guidelines circulated vide NCTE letter dated 11-02-2011, a person who is pursuing any of the teacher education courses (recognized by the NCTE or the RCI, as the case may be) specified in the NCTE Notification dated 23rd August 2010 is also qualified to appear in the TET/CTET.	

Steps for Application –

- To Apply: www.ctet.nic.in
- Go to the link “Apply Online” and open the same.
- Fill in the Online Application Form and note down Registration No. /Application No.
- Upload Scanned Images of latest Photograph and Signature
- Pay Examination Fee by e-challan of Syndicate Bank e-Challan or Canara Bank e-Challan or debit/credit card.
- Print Confirmation page for record and future reference.

Documents Required –

- **Upload scanned photograph.** Size 10KB – 100KB. Dimension of photograph should be 3.5 cm (width) x 4.5 cm (height).
- **Scanned copy of candidate’s full signature.** Size 3KB – 30KB. Dimension of signature should be 3.5 cm (length) x 1.5 cm (height).
- Scanned image of latest photograph and signature in JPG/JPEG format only.
- A copy of Class X Certificate.
