IDFC First Bank MBA Scholarship 2023-25

IDFC FIRST Bank MBA Scholarship is a need-based scholarship program run by IDFC FIRST Bank to financially support students with family income of less than INR 6 lakh per annum. The purpose of this scholarship is to make post-graduate studies in business management accessible to meritorious students who are unable to pursue higher studies due to financial constraints. Under this scholarship, students enrolled into the first year of a two-year full-time MBA course in the academic session 2023-25 will be provided with INR 2 lakh for two years of their MBA program (INR 1 lakh/year).

Eligibility -

- Open for Indian Nationals, residing in India only.
- Students enrolled in first year of a 2-year full-time MBA program or its equivalent for the class of 2023 are eligible.
- Applicants should be enrolled in any of the MBA colleges mentioned on the website of buddy4study.
- The gross annual family income of the applicants from all sources should be less than or equal to INR 6 lakh.
- Candidates should be no more than 35 years of age on the date of application.
- The applicant must have a valid mobile number linked to Aadhaar card.

Steps for Application -

- Click and register: https://tinyurl.com/buddy4study
- You will now be redirected to the 'IDFC FIRST Bank MBA Scholarship' official website.
- Read all the details carefully and click on the 'Apply Now' button.
- Check your eligibility and get your Aadhaar card and mobile number verified.
- Login to the application portal and fill in all the required details in the online scholarship application form.
- Upload the required documents.
- Finally, submit the application form.

Documents -

- Admission proof (with name of institution, admission year and batch)
- Copy of Fee Receipt.
- Copy of Graduation mark sheet/passing certificate
- Income Proof (any one)
 - Certificate issued by relevant government authority (Tehsildar or Magistrate)
 - Copy of Income Tax Returns (Form 16A)
 - Copy of Salary Slip
- Other Documents (If applicable)
 - Disability certificate
 - Sanctioned loan letter
 - Death certificate, if there is a death of the sole earning member of the immediate family
 - Document of any other scholarships received for pursuing MBA
