



## Jharkhand Teacher Eligibility Test 2026

Jharkhand Academic Council has officially released JTET Notification 2026 on March 28, 2026, and the application process has started from April 21, 2026, on its official website. The Jharkhand Teacher Eligibility Test (JTET) is conducted to determine the eligibility of candidates for teaching positions in primary (Classes 1-5) and upper primary (Classes 6-8) schools across the state.

### Eligibility –

<b>Paper 1 (Classes 1-5)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Senior Secondary (or equivalent) with at least 45% marks and a 2-year Diploma in Elementary Education</li> <li>Senior Secondary (or equivalent) with at least 50% marks and a 4-year Bachelor of Elementary Education (B.El.Ed)</li> <li>Senior Secondary (or equivalent) with at least 50% marks and a 2-year Diploma in Special Education</li> <li>Graduation (BA/B.Sc.) with at least 50% marks and a B.Ed degree from a recognized university.</li> </ul>
<b>Paper 2 (Classes 6-8)</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Graduation with at least 45% marks and a 2-year D.Ed. (completed or in final year)</li> <li>Graduation with at least 50% marks and a B.Ed degree (completed or in final year)</li> <li>Senior Secondary (or equivalent) with at least 50% marks and a 4-year B.El.Ed. or B.A.B.Ed./B.Sc.B.Ed (completed or in final year)</li> <li>B.A. (Education), B.Sc. (Education), or B.Ed. (Special Education) with at least 50% marks.</li> </ul>
<b>Age</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Candidate's minimum age must be 21 years before 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2026</li> </ul>
<b>Citizenship</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must be an Indian</li> </ul>

### Steps for Application –

- Visit the website for registration: <https://jactetonline.com/>
- Choose the exam level you wish to apply for and complete the registration
- Log-in using your registration ID and password
- Fill in the required details, including educational qualifications and preferred exam centres.
- Upload scanned copies of your recent photograph and signature in the prescribed format.
- Pay the application fee online using Debit/Credit Card or Internet Banking.
- Submit the JTET Application and download the confirmation page for future reference.
