National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA)

The National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) measures the aptitude of the applicant for specific field of study, i.e. Architecture. The test measures drawing and observation skills, sense of proportion, aesthetic sensitivity and critical thinking ability that have been acquired over a long period of time, and that are related to specific field of study, i.e. Architecture.

NATA happens twice a year. A candidate can appear either for first test or Second Test or can chose to appear in both tests. Highest marks obtained in either of the two examinations would be awarded to him/ her as final marks.

Eligibility –

- 10+2 passed or appearing with Mathematics as a mandatory subjects with at least 50% marks.
- 10+3 Diploma holders (any stream)/ appearing recognized by Central/ State Government with Mathematics as one of the subjects with 50 % marks.
- The candidates belonging to SC, ST, OBC-NCL category or PwD (Persons with disability) shall be provided a relaxation of 5% marks in total aggregate in 10+2 level/10+3 Diploma as well as PCM.
- There is no age criterion for appearing in NATA 2020
- There are not any lateral admission criteria for admission in any stage/year of B.Arch. course.
- There is no relaxation for special category students (SC/ST/OBC) for the purpose of admission.

Steps for Application –

- Click: <https://nataregistration.in/> and 'New Registration'.
- Enter User ID and Password to log in again.
- Fill Online Application Form (Personal Details; Communicating Address; Choice of Examination Center; Academic Details like 10th and 12th Mark sheet, SC/ST category certificates, etc.)
- Scan and Upload the required documents –
 - **Photo** – File size: 4 KB-100 KB (JPG/JPEG)
 - **Signature** – File size: 1KB – 30KB (JPG/JPEG)
- **Application fee** - Fee for the first or second test will be Rs.2000/- .In case the Candidate wishes to appear for both tests, he/she shall deposit Rs. 3800/- .SC/ST/PwD candidates need to deposit Rs.1700/- for either first or second test or Rs.3100/- for appearing in both the tests.
- **Online mode:** Payment through EPG: The candidate has to click "Payment of fee using EPG services", the system will automatically redirect to available payment gateway page, displayed at the web site. As per the candidate's convenience Fee can be paid using Debit/Credit Cards or Internet Banking.

Other Information –

- Carry a valid photo ID proof (Aadhaar Card/Voter ID/ Passport/Driving license) along with Admit Card at the examination center.
- **NATA 2020 Exam** consists of 2 parts –
 - **Part A:** To be answered on A4 size drawing sheets. It assess candidate's drawing/ sketching skills
 - **Part B:** Comprises of Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) to be answered online. It tests candidates on General Aptitude and Knowledge of Mathematics, Physics, & Chemistry.Both the papers will be conducted on the same day with each paper being allotted 90 minutes for completion and it is mandatory for a candidate to attempt both the papers. There is no negative marking.
