



## UPSC NDA 2 2021 Application Form

**NDA (2) 2021** will be conducted by Union Public Service Commission. Application form will be released on 09 June 2021 (Tentative). **National Defence Academy** is an entrance exam organized at the national level for the candidates who wish to be a part of Indian Navy, Air Force and Army.

### Eligibility –

- Unmarried
- Between 16.5 and 19.5 years (Applicant must be born between 2nd January 2003 and 1st January 2006)
- Qualify Class 12th with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics as their compulsory subject to be eligible for examination (for Air Force and Naval Wings of National Defence Academy and the 10+2 Cadet Entry Scheme at the Indian Naval Academy)
- Qualify Class 12th Class or equivalent examination conducted by a State Education Board or a University (for Army Wing of National Defence Academy)

### Steps for Application –

- Visit the official website – [www.upsc.gov.in/www.upsconline.nic.in](http://www.upsc.gov.in/www.upsconline.nic.in) to register for the NDA 2 2021 exam.
- Click on the option '**National Defence Academy & Naval Academy Examination (2) Part 1**'
- To register, fill the form asking for the candidate's basic information
- Fill the post preference and verify details before submitting
- When part 2 of the page opens, pay the application fee (Rs. 100)
- Upload the scanned documents (file size should be within 20kb and 300kb, and must not exceed the file size limit)
- Submit the application form
- Print the confirmation page for future reference

**Note – Candidates should note that the fees once paid are not refunded. So, they should be careful while paying the application fees.**

### Other Information –

- Mark sheet and admit card of Class 10 and 12
- Photo-identity card in PDF format (Aadhaar Card/Voter Card/PAN Card/Passport/Driving License/School Photo ID/Any other photo ID Card issued by the State/Central Government)
- Scanned images of photograph and signature
- Bank details to make an online transaction
