National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) 2024

The National Testing Agency (NTA) has started the online registration process from 9 Feb 2024 for the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) 2024. Candidates who were waiting for the NEET UG 2024 Application Form can now fill the form.

The NEET 2024 exam is scheduled for May 5, 2024. Additionally, alongside the NEET 2024 application form, the NTA has also published the information bulletin. Stay updated with live updates on the NEET UG 2024 registration process, dates, eligibility criteria, fees, application process, required documents, and other relevant information.

Eligibility –

- Indian Nationals, Non-Resident Indians (NRIs), Overseas Citizens of India (OCIs), Persons of Indian Origin (PIOs), and Foreign Nationals are eligible.
- Age should be 17 years as of December 31, 2024. No upper age limit for appearing in NEET UG.
- Must have passed 10+2 or equivalent with Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology, and English as core subjects.
- Minimum aggregate marks: General category 50%, SC/ST/OBC 40%, PwD 45% in Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology (taken together).
- Unlimited attempts are permitted

Steps for Application -

- Register: https://neet.ntaonline.in/frontend/web/registration/index
- Fill the required details in the online application form.
- Upload relevant documents.
- Accept the 'Terms and Conditions' and click on 'Preview'.
- If all the details filled in by the applicant are correctly showing on the preview screen, click on the 'Submit' button to complete the application process.

Note: The application fee is Rs. 1700 for General category, Rs. 1600 for EWS/OBC category, and Rs. 1000 for SC/ST/PwD category.
