

## **Scholarship: 2018-19**

# **National Means -cum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS)**

The objective is to award scholarships to meritorious students of economically weaker sections to arrest their drop out at class VIII and encourage them to continue the study at secondary stage. One lakh scholarships @ Rs.6000/- per annum (Rs.500/- per month) are awarded to selected students. There is quota of scholarships for different States/UTs.

### **Eligibility**

- Parental income from all sources is not more than Rs. 1, 50, 000/- per annum.
- The selection of students for award of scholarships under the scheme is made through an examination conducted by the State Governments.
- The students shall have minimum of 55% marks or equivalent grade in Class VII examination for appearing in selection test for award of scholarship.
- The candidate must have scored at least 55% marks or equivalent grade in Class VIII examination.
- The students must pass both the tests i.e. MAT and SAT with at least 40% marks in each.
- Students of Class IX and X need to apply under Pre- Matric scholarship category whereas students of class XI and XII need to apply under Post- Matric scholarship category.
- Only two application can be submitted through one mobile.

### **Documents Required –**

- Income certificate would be required for the fresh applicants only.
- Aadhaar Card number.
- Students need to provide Bank branch IFSC code, active bank account number and name of bank as printed on their bank passbook. Students also need to upload the copy of their bank passbook.
- Students Score Cards.
