

National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA)

National Aptitude Test in Architecture (NATA) is being conducted by COA since 2006, to qualify for the admission to Bachelor of Architecture. Unlike any other entrance examination, NATA is an Aptitude test that assesses a candidate's ability through a variety of testing formats.

NATA measures the aptitude of the applicant for Architecture, through assessment of cognitive skills, visual perception and aesthetic sensitivity tests, logical reasoning and critical thinking ability, etc., besides other learnings.

The candidates can appear for maximum of 3 attempts in NATA 2024 in one academic year. The best score out of all the attempts shall be considered for declaration of results.

Eligibility –

- Passed or appearing in 10+1 Examination with PCM Subjects
- Passed or appearing in 10+2 Examination with PCM subjects
- Passed or appearing in 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as subjects:

Steps for Application –

- Complete the online application form with personal, educational, and contact details. Make sure to double-check all the information provided before submitting.
- Upload Documents as specified in the application form.
- Pay the application fee online through the available payment options on the website. (Keep a copy of the transaction receipt for future reference).
- Choose your preferred exam center location from the available list of centers provided in the brochure: https://www.nata.in/NATA_BROCHURE_2024.pdf?v123
- Review all the details filled in the application form and submit it online. Once submitted, you will receive a confirmation email or SMS with your application details.

Note: After successful registration, download and print the admit card from the official website within the specified time frame before the exam date.

Document Required –

- A copy of the candidate's Class 10 mark sheet to verify date of birth.
- A copy of the Class 12 mark sheet showing the candidate's academic qualifications.
- A recent passport-sized colored photograph with both ears visible and front view only - jpg / jpeg format (4KB -100 KB, Size – Height 4.5 cm and Width 3.5 cm)
- A scanned copy of the candidate's signature in jpg / jpeg format. (1KB – 30KB, Size – Height 1.5 cm and Width 3.5 cm)
