



# Reliance Foundation Scholarships 2021-22

Reliance Foundation Scholarships are a pioneering initiative aimed at nurturing India's technology leaders of tomorrow. Reliance Foundation will identify and support 100 of India's brightest first-year undergraduate and postgraduate students who are pursuing degree programmes in Artificial Intelligence, Computer Sciences, Mathematics and Computing and Electrical and/or Electronics Engineering. Up to 60 undergraduate students will receive a grant of up to INR 4 Lakh each, while up to 40 postgraduate students will be awarded up to INR 6 Lakh each for the duration of their degree.

## Eligibility –

- Open for Indian nationals only.
- Applicants must be currently enrolled full-time in the first year of undergraduate or postgraduate degree programme in the following subjects:
- Artificial Intelligence, Computer Sciences, Mathematics & Computing, and Electrical and/or Electronics Engineering.
- For Undergraduate Scholarships: Applicants who secured a rank of 1-35,000 in the JEE Main (Paper 1) Examination can apply.
- For Postgraduate Scholarships: Applicants who secured a score of 550-1,000 in the GATE examination, OR applicants who have not attempted GATE and have scored 7.5 or above in their undergraduate CGPA (or % normalised to CGPA) can apply.
- Applicants from all institutes in India are eligible, subject to meeting the eligibility criteria.

## Steps for Application –

- Click on 'Apply Now'.
- Fill the online Eligibility Questionnaire.
- If you fulfil the eligibility criteria, you will be sent an email invitation with log-in information to apply through Reliance Foundation's application portal.
- Log in to the application portal using the username and password received on email.
- Fill the scholarship application form and upload necessary documents.
- Submit the application.

- Address Proof (for address ticked as preferred physical correspondence address)
- Current Resume
- Mark sheet of 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Class Board Examination
- Mark sheet of JEE Main Entrance Examination (for Undergraduate students) OR Mark sheet of GATE Entrance Examination (for Postgraduate students, if applicable)
- Official transcript/ Mark sheet of your undergraduate degree (for Postgraduate students)
- Bonafide Student Certificate of current college/institution of enrollment, or Student ID Card
- 2 Reference Letters: 1 academic and 1 character
