Eligibility –

To qualify for the scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Students in Classes 6 to 12 are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must have achieved a minimum of 75% marks in the preceding academic year.
- The annual family income of the applicant should not exceed INR 3,00,000 from all sources.
- Students from across PAN India are welcome to apply.

Documents –

- Mark sheet from the previous academic year.
- Government-issued identity proof (Aadhaar card).
- Proof of current year admission (fee receipt/admission letter/institution identity card/bonafide certificate).
- Bank account details of the applicant (or parent).
- Income proof (Form 16A/income certificate from government authority/salary slips, etc.).
- Photograph of the applicant.
