Eligibility –

- Open for Indian students who have lost their parent(s) or earning family member/s due to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be studying in Class 6 to 12/ Diploma/Polytechnic course/ B.com/ B.sc/ BBA/ BA/ Engineering/ Law/ Medical etc. at a recognized educational institution in India.
- They must have scored at least 60% marks in the preceding class.
- The annual family income must be less than or equal to INR 4,00,000 (4 lakh) from all sources.
- Children of employees of Tata Capital & Buddy4Study are not eligible.

Steps for Application –

- Fill the required details in the online application form and upload relevant documents
- Accept the ‘Terms and Conditions’ and click on ‘Preview’.
- If all the details filled in the application are correctly showing on the preview screen, click on the ‘Submit’ button to complete the application process.

Documents –

- Photo identity proof (Aadhaar Card)
- Passport size photograph
- Income proof (Form 16A/income certificate from government authority/salary slips, etc.)
- Proof of admission (school/college ID card/bonafide certificate, etc.)
- Current academic year fee receipt
- Proof of death of parent(s) or earning member due to COVID-19 (death certificate/hospital receipt/doctor prescription/COVID-19 test report/medical bills for COVID-19 medication, etc.)
- Bank account details of the scholarship applicant (cancelled cheque/passbook copy)
- Marksheets or grade card of preceding class
- Disability & Caste certificate (if applicable)
