

UP PET (Uttar Pradesh Preliminary Eligibility Test) 2026

UPSSSC PET Notification 2026 has been released. The Preliminary Eligibility Test is a state-level qualifying exam conducted by the Uttar Pradesh Subordinate Services Selection Commission. It serves as a gateway for candidates seeking eligibility for various Group C posts in the Uttar Pradesh government.

Eligibility

- Must have passed Class 10 (High School) or an equivalent examination from a recognized board.
- Minimum age: 18 years.
- Maximum age: 40 years (age relaxation as per government rules)

Benefits of UP PET

- Qualifying examination for various UPSSSC Group C recruitments.
- One PET score can be used to apply for multiple eligible recruitments during its validity period.
- Reduces the need to appear for separate preliminary examinations for each recruitment.
- Used for recruitments such as Lekhpal, Village Development Officer (VDO), Junior Assistant, Forest Guard, Stenographer, and other posts notified by UPSSSC

Steps for Application –

- Visit: <https://upsssc.gov.in/>
- Completed One Time Registration (OTR)
- Click on “Apply Online” and Fill application form
- Upload photograph & signature
- Pay fee online
- Download confirmation n page

Documents –

- Class 10th & 12th Certificate
- Aadhaar card
- Recent Passport-size Photograph
- Signature, residence proof.

Steps for Selection-

- Appear in the UP PET examination.
- Obtain a valid PET score.
- Apply for the desired UPSSSC recruitment when notifications are released.
- Shortlisting based on PET score (as applicable).
- Main Written Examination and Document Verification.
- Medical Examination/Skill Test, if required for the specific post.
