



Young, Upcoming and Versatile Authors (PM-YUVA) 2.0

This year PM YUVA (Young, Upcoming and Versatile Authors) was launched to train young and budding authors up to the age of 30 years in order to promote reading, writing and book culture in the country, and project India and Indian writings globally. After 1st success now we have PM YUVA 2.0 as a national scheme for mentoring generations of young authors.

The National Book Trust, India will ensure phase-wise execution of the Scheme under well-defined stages of mentorship.

Eligibility –

- Contestants should not have any personal, professional, or academic obligations that interfere with the mentorship schedule during the PM-YUVA 2.0.
- The maximum age of the contestant should be exactly 30 years or below as on 2nd October 2022.
- Entry can be sent through MyGov and only one entry per contestant is allowed.
- Once an entry has been submitted, it cannot be edited or withdrawn.
- It should have a chapter plan, synopsis and two-three sample chapters with 10,000 as maximum word limit as per the following format –

1	Synopsis	2000-3000 words
2	Chapter Plan	
3	Two-three sample chapters	7000-8000 words
4	Bibliography and References

- Now submit your entry for the PM YUVA 2.0 scheme.
